

## Registration for HCBA Disaster Relief Training

### Tennessee DR Training Facts:

To become fully credentialed, you must take at least one specialized classroom training (e.g. chainsaw, flood recovery, shower/laundry, etc.) after you have taken the prerequisite course of "Introduction to Southern Baptist Disaster Relief."

Disaster Relief credentials and the yellow hat/visor will be given after "Introduction to Southern Baptist Disaster Relief" and specialized classes have been taken.

If it has been over 5 years since you last took Introduction to Disaster Relief and/or specialized classes, you will need to take the full Introduction to Disaster Relief and classroom specialized class(es) in person.

### Cost Information for Disaster Relief:

Because of directives from Homeland Security, FEMA and other national agencies related to the training and screening of volunteer disaster relief workers, we have a cost recovery plan. The cost of a new 3 year (ID badge) credential is \$36.00 (for newly trained volunteers or those that had credentials that expire in 2021). Checks can be made out to TBMB (Tennessee Baptist Mission Board).

This fee will cover not only the cost of the ID and background check but also the cost of any of the basic training courses a volunteer wants to take.
